Nominations for Aboriginal and/or Torres Strait Islander people, organisations and businesses who have made a significant contribution to our community are now welcome for a 2022 NAIDOC Perth Award

ELIGIBILITY GUIDELINES

1. Nominees for individual awards must be Aboriginal and/or Torres Strait Islander (they must identify as Aboriginal and/or Torres Strait Islander and be accepted by the Aboriginal and/or Torres Strait Islander community as such).
2. Nominees must have lived in Perth, Western Australia for the majority of period between 1st January, 2020 and present (Perth is defined as: south to Mandurah, north to Yanchep and east to Mundaring), The only exception to this is for the Nursing and Midwifery Award, those nominees can live and work anywhere in WA.
3. Nominees for the Outstanding Achievement Award must currently live in Perth and have done so for a minimum of five (5) years.
4. NAIDOC Perth Members and previous NAIDOC Perth Committee Members since 1st January, 2020 cannot nominate or be nominated.
5. Nomination applications can also be completed **ONLINE**, follow the link via NAIDOC Perth's Facebook page or as shown on this form.
6. Nominations must address the Award Criteria. Nominees can be nominated for more than one Award, but a separate application must be lodged for each nomination.
7. Nomination applications must be received by **6pm Monday, May 23, 2022**. Late nominations will not be accepted.
8. Referees are be provided for selected Finalists.
9. The decision of the judges will be final and no correspondence will be entered in to.
10. Finalists will be invited to the NAIDOC Perth Awards Dinner on **Saturday, 25th June, 2022** at Crown, Burswood. Award Winners will be announced on this night.
11. Winners will be promoted prior to NAIDOC Week 2022 (3rd to 10th July).

2022 NAIDOC Perth Award Categories

Outstanding Achievement Award

This prestigious award is open to an individual who has contributed significantly to the development and empowerment of Perth's Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander communities over a five (5) year period or more. The chosen recipient will have demonstrated exceptional leadership, vision, empowerment and cultural integrity on the individual and/or collective level.

Youth of the Year

This prestigious award is open to an individual under the age of 25 years who has contributed significantly to the development and empowerment of Perth's Aboriginal and/or Torres Strait Islander youth and services over a two (2) year period or more. The recipient will have demonstrated leadership and cultural integrity.

Elders of the Year

1 x Female and 1 x Male

These Awards are open to people who are considered to be Elders within their family or community. No age restrictions have been set for these Awards. Elders who are positive role models who have contributed to their families and communities over a number of years will be looked upon favourably.

Education Achievement Award

Includes students at Secondary (High School) and Tertiary (TAFE or University) institutions as well as those in Vocational Education and Training (VET) Programs. The Award applies to students who are currently studying or who have completed their studies.

Community Person of the Year

This Award is open to people who have made a significant contribution to the Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander community of Perth. The recipient will have demonstrated Leadership and cultural integrity in their service to the community.

Sportsperson of the Year

This Award is open to individuals who have in the past or are currently excelling in a particular field of sport from a wide range of sports including all ball sports, water sports, athletics, dance, martial arts/combat and any other competitive sports as deemed suitable.

Carer of the Year

This Award is open to individuals who are Carers in a paid or voluntary capacity. This includes caring for the elderly, unwell, disabled, their own or other people's children (e.g. foster children, grandchildren, nieces and nephews, siblings, children and young people in hostels or family group homes)

Program of the Year

This Award is open to Not-for-profit organisations that deliver quality Programs to the Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander community and is based in the Perth metropolitan area.

Artist(s) of the Year

This Award is open to visual or performing Artists such as Painters, Designers, Photographers and Film makers, Sculptors, Dancers, Musicians, Singers, Actors, etc. Open to individuals and groups.

Nursing & Midwifery Award (State-wide)

Open to any practicing Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander Nursing & Midwifery employee from across Western Australia. This award recognises the commitment of an individual who provides care within health. This award acknowledges their excellence in delivering safe, quality care to the community.

Business of the Year

This Award is open to successful businesses that are at least 50% Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander owned and based in the Perth metropolitan area. Examples include (but not limited to) Indigenous Printing, Clothing/attire, Trade, Tourism, Science & Technology, etc.

2022 NAIDOC Theme Award

Open to an individual, a group or an organisation that best demonstrates what the NAIDOC Theme signifies in the Perth Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander community.

Empowerment Award

Specifically selected from all applications **by the NAIDOC Perth Committee** with a focus on empowering Aboriginal & Torres Strait Islander Youth in the Perth Metropolitan community.
